You are hereby notified that the City Council of the City of Cresco, Iowa, will hold a Public Hearing on the 15th day of August, 2022, in Council Chambers at City Hall. At this meeting the Council proposes to amend Ordinance Chapter 99 Sections 02 and 03 regarding sewer service charges.

The proposed amendments may be viewed at Cresco City Hall during normal office hours or online at www.cityofcresco.com. This hearing will be conducted during a regular Cresco City Council Meeting starting at 5:30 pm.

Any resident of Cresco wishing to be heard concerning the reasons for, or objections to, the amendment, must appear at said hearing and voice your opinions.

City Clerk Michelle Elton

Mayor Brenno called the Cresco City Council meeting to order on August 1, 2022, at 5:30 pm. Council Members Kriener, McConnell, Fortune, Bouska, and Carman were present. No council members were absent.

McConnell made the motion to approve the consent agenda which included approval of the: agenda; claims; minutes from July 18, 2022 Council meeting; Street Closing Permit for portion of 2nd Ave West for Atomic Pizza expanded beer garden for Harvest Fest and 5-Year Atomic Anniversary on August 27, 2022; Special Class C Liquor License (BW) with outdoor service and Sunday service to Atomic Pizza Pub LLC d/b/a Atomic Pizza Pub (expanded beer garden); Street Closing Permit for portion of alley between 112 and 114 N Elm going west for The Pub expanded beer garden for Harvest Fest on August 27, 2022; Special Class C Liquor License (LC) with outdoor service and Sunday service to Barbara E. Holstrom d/b/a The Pub. Bouska seconded and it passed all ayes.

Public Works Director Widell reported: (a) the fence is finished at the Sewer Plant except the gate that will be installed in a few weeks; (b) the Street Department will finish chip sealing this week. Due to the high cost of oil, we will not do a third load; (c) Well #4 has had frequent communication errors and alarm issues due to high humidity, so we installed a mini-split unit to cool it and reduce the humidity; (d) S&M Underground is in town installing conduit for Harmony Telephone Company for fiber for internet services that is part of a large multi-county project.

Police Chief Ruroden reported: (a) they had 60 animal calls, 25 medical assist calls, and 19 arrests and charges filed in June; (b) one officer is testing for the 9-week academy and another for the 16-week academy.

Clerk Elton reported: (a) Mediacom notified us they are raising rates 25% on four of their packages; (b) an analysis was presented for the Special Events held at the Theatre; (c) will give Department Heads the Capital Improvement Plan and sheets to update the plan in October.

Kriener reported that he accompanied Scott from WHKS to inspect the basements downtown and were happy to see that most issues were addressed in 1983 when the City repaved North Elm Street and installed new watermain. The Engineers will continue drafting the specs for the potential Downtown Crosswalk Project.

Mayor Brenno asked for comments from the audience and there were none.

Stan Shimek and Mark Shimek from Shimek Sanitation Service reported that they were contacted from several commercial businesses due to the high rate increase for dumpsters. The current agreement with Hawkeye Sanitation states that commercial garbage collection will be negotiated directly between the collector and the commercial business. Commercial is considered a business that utilizes a dumpster. Light commercial (businesses that do not need a dumpster) and residential garbage collection is billed by the City for any property that has water utilities active and paid to Hawkeye Sanitation. Recycling is also billed by the City and paid to Hawkeye Sanitation. Council unanimously agreed to draft an agreement allowing other commercial garbage haulers to contract directly with commercial accounts for dumpsters if they have a signed agreement with the City of Cresco. The proposed agreement will be reviewed and possibly approved at the next council meeting with Shimek Sanitation.

The existing Solid Waste Ordinances will be reviewed and updated to address multiple garbage collectors for commercial businesses with dumpsters.

Council reviewed the long-term debt balances and amortization schedules. Carman made the motion to approve the Outstanding Obligation Report. Kriener seconded and it passed all ayes.

Carman made the motion to approve the resolution accepting the Annual Financial Report of the City of Cresco, Iowa for the fiscal year 2021-2022 and directing the City Clerk to file the report with the Iowa Auditor of State. McConnell seconded and it passed all ayes.

McConnell made the motion to set a Public Hearing for August 15, 2022 to amend Chapter 99 Sections 02 and 03 in the City of Cresco Code of Ordinances pertaining to sewer service charges. Kriener seconded and it passed all ayes. This amendment does not increase rates but just adds the BOD5 monthly charge for Industrial Users.

Bouska made the motion to approve the first reading of proposed Ordinance 496 which amends Chapter 99 Sections 02 and 03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, pertaining to sewer service charges. Carman seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to approve the resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into an Agreement for an Extension of the Current Industrial Sewer Rental Agreement with AVEKA Group, Cresco Facility (f/k/a Cresco Food Technologies, LLC). Carman seconded and it passed all ayes.


In appreciation for the work that the Police Officers perform and the difficulty of recruiting and retaining qualified Police Officers the Council agreed to offer a \$5,000 bonus for Officers after five years of employment with the City. Kriener made the motion to approve the Resolution Implementing a Police Retention Bonus Program. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to waive the \$750 Building Permit fee for the Howard-Winneshiek Community School District Building Project. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska moved to adjourn at 5:57 pm. Carman seconded and it passed all ayes. The next regular Cresco City Council meeting will be August 15, 2022, at 5:30 pm at Cresco City Hall.





ORDINANCE NO. 496

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Cresco, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 99, Sections 02 and 03, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, are repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

99.02 RATES FOR SERVICE. Each customer shall pay a sewer service charge for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system based upon the amount and rate of water consumed. Sewer service shall be furnished at the following monthly rates:

(Code of Iowa, Section 384.84)

- 1. Effective July 1, 2022:
- A. \$9.56 per 1,000 gallons within City limits. (Minimum bill is \$14.34 based on 1,500 gallons.)
- \$19.12 per 1,000 gallons outside City limits. (Minimum bill is \$28.67 based on 1,500 gallons.)
- C. \$8.55 per 1,000 gallons for high volume users that are subject to Industrial Sewer Rental Agreements with the City.
- D. \$7.20 per pound per day BOD5 x 30-day average BOD5 (ppd) for users subject to Industrial Sewer Rental Agreements with the City (where BOD5 refers to biochemical oxygen demand).

99.03 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

A. \$3.50 per month charge for a special fund for the extension and maintenance of the sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and water lines.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 498

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES "ATV" AND SNOWMOBILES

Below is a summary of ORDINANCE 498. A full copy of said Ordinance may be obtained between 8 am and 4:30 pm weekdays at City Hall, 130 North Park Place, Cresco, IA 52136 or on the City's website at www.cityofcresco.com.

SECTION 1. Chapter 75.03, 75.05, and 75.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, is amended as summarized below:

Iowa Code Section 321I.10 was amended to allow a city to designate which streets may be used for the operation of a registered ATV within city limits.

The City of Cresco does not allow for the operation of an ATV, off-road motorcycle, or snowmobile on any streets within the City. Exceptions and rules are listed in chapter 75 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, and include agricultural purposes and snow removal.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO 498

ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES AND SNOWMOBILES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES "ATV" AND SNOWMOBILES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Cresco, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Sections 75.03, 75.05 and 75.08 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, are modified and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

75.03 GENERAL REGULATIONS.

Iowa Code Section 321I.10 subsection 3 states that a city may regulate the operation of registered ATVs and may designate streets under the jurisdiction of the city within its corporate limits, and two-lane primary and secondary road extensions in the city, which may be used for the operation of such vehicles.

The City of Cresco does not allow for the operation of an ATV, off-road motorcycle, or snowmobile on any streets within the City. Exceptions and rules are listed in sections 75.04 and 75.05.

75.05 OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES. The operators of ATVs shall comply with the following restrictions as to where ATVs may be operated within the City:

- 1. Streets. ATVs shall not be operated on a city street unless one or more of the following conditions apply:
 - a. The operation is between sunrise and sunset and is incidental to the vehicle's use for agricultural purposes. For purposes of this paragraph, "incidental to the vehicle's use for agricultural purposes" includes stopping in the course of agricultural use to obtain fuel for the ATV or to obtain food or a nonalcoholic beverage for the operator.
 - b. The operation is incidental to the vehicle's use for the purpose of surveying by a licensed engineer or land surveyor.
 - c. The ATV is operated by an employee or agent of a political subdivision or public utility for the purpose of construction or maintenance on or adjacent to the city street.
 - d. The ATV is operated by an employee or agent of a public agency as defined in Iowa Code Section 34.1 for the purpose of providing emergency services or rescue.
 - e. The ATV is operated for the purpose of mowing, installing approved trail signs, or providing maintenance on a snowmobile or ATV trail designated by the Department of Natural Resources.

f. The ATV is operated for the purpose of snow removal and travels on the most direct route between properties or to obtain fuel.

The following paragraphs are added.

- 6. A person operating an ATV in the city pursuant to subsection 1, paragraphs "a" or "f", shall not operate upon any City street that is a primary road extension through the City. However, ATV's may cross such a primary road extension. Within the City of Cresco, "primary road extension" shall be taken to mean Highway 9 (2nd Avenue SE/SW), 3rd Street West (Granger), and 3rd Street SW (Protivin Road).
- 7. A person operating an ATV on a highway shall have a valid driver's license and operate the vehicle at speeds of thirty-five miles per hour or less. In addition, a person operating an ATV on a highway pursuant to subsection 1, paragraphs "b" through "f", shall be at least eighteen years of age and have financial liability coverage in effect for the vehicle and carry proof of such financial liability coverage in accordance with section 321.20B.
- 75.08 EQUIPMENT ON MOTOR VEHICLES. An ATV is a motor vehicle for purposes of this chapter. Therefore, an ATV operated on a highway shall be equipped with the parts, lamps, and other equipment in proper condition and adjustment as required under the Iowa Code chapter 321 for motor vehicles, including but not limited to the parts, lamps, and equipment required under Section 321.386 (headlamps), 321.387 (rear lamps), 321.404 (brake lights), 321.432 (horn), and 321.437 (mirror) of the Code of Iowa.

Every ATV shall be equipped with at least one and not more than two headlamps. An ATV shall display lighted headlamps at all times while the vehicle is operated on a city street.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

The City will no longer inspect or issue City of Cresco permits to operate a UTV on a public street or alley within city limits. Additional equipment requirements were added per State Code for a horn and headlamps.

Golf carts still need to be inspected and to purchase a permit from the City annually.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

GOLF CARTS AND UTVs (UTILITY TRAIL VEHICLES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO GOLF CARTS AND UTILITY TRAIL VEHICLES (UTVs)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTIONS MODIFIED. Chapter 74.05 (section 2e and 2f), 74.06 and 74.10 (sections 2, 3.B, 4, 5, & 6) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, lowa, is amended and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

74.05 EQUIPMENT:

Section 2. UTV's operated upon City streets shall be equipped with at least the following:

(The following equipment is added under Section 2)

- E. Horn (lowa Code 321,432)
- F. Headlamps (iowa Code 321.387)
- **74.06 HOURS:** Golf carts and UTV's may be operated on City streets only between sunrise and sunset, except that a UTV may be operated during prohibited hours to perform snow removal or agricultural activities.
- **74.10 PERMITS:** No person shall operate a golf cart or UTV on any public street or alley for any purpose unless the operator possesses a City of Cresco permit to operate a golf cart or DNR Registration to operate a UTV on City Streets.
- 2. Golf cart and UTV owners need to apply for a permit from the City of Cresco Police Department to operate a golf cart or UTV on City streets.
 - 3. A permit shall not be issued until the owner has provided the following:
 - B. Proof that the owner and all permitted operators have liability insurance covering operation of a golf cart or UTV on City Streets with limits of liability at least as great as those required by the Code of Iowa chapter 321A.1.11 as amended.
- 4. Any golf cart or UTV operated on the City streets shall display the City of Cresco permit sticker prominently on a rear fender or similar component.
- 5. All permits issued shall uniquely identify the name(s) and address(es) of the owner and all permitted operators and shall be for a specific golf cart or UTV, as evidenced by its serial number.

6. The fee for such permits shall be twenty-five dollars (25.00) per year. The fee will not be pro-rated for permit's purchased during the year. The fee will not be refunded if the golf cart or UTV is sold, or the permit is suspended or revoked.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

 - A. City Permit. An application must be filed with City Hall that includes:
 - 1. The location and dates for the sale of fireworks. Sales of consumer fireworks are allowed only within districts zoned as Commercial C-1 or C-2 and Industrial M-1.
