The proposed amendment may be viewed at Cresco City Hall during normal office hours or online at www.cityofcresco.com. This hearing will be conducted during a regular Cresco City Council Meeting starting at 7:00 pm.

Any resident of Cresco wishing to be heard concerning the reasons for or objections to the amendment, must appear at said hearing and voice your opinions.

Fireworks Ordinance – Public hearing and 2nd reading. Amendment basically makes it illegal to discharge fireworks in city limits except July 3rd and July 4th each year. Full copy of ordinance is included.

Sewer Credit – see letter requesting credit for sewer charges for water not entering sanitary sewer. Please review the list of council actions for previous requests. (“preventable” is often used in rationalizing the decision) Also, please note that we have several customers watering their yards this summer. Their bills for June & July have been \$180 to \$300 higher each month and in August they were \$330 to \$540 higher than normal. No credits are available to them for watering their yards.

Jake Braking Ordinance – See note requesting a Jake Braking Ordinance be implemented. Council needs to decide if it is an issue that needs to be addressed to justify the costs for signage and ordinance publication and codification fees.

AFR – this report must be filed annually with the Auditor of the State. It is made available online for the public by the State Auditor. The front page must be published and the report must be approved by Council by resolution prior to submitting it.

SFR – this report must be filed annually with the Iowa DOT. It must be approved by Council by resolution prior to submitting it. RUT funds will be withheld for failure to file this report.

W/O Uncollectible – an estate was closed and no money was left for paying off creditors so we are unable to collect the \$84.73 balance.

Dev Agreement – see attached letter from Aaron Wemark regarding the house that has not been built in accordance with the Development Agreement. By delaying the construction by a year costs the City about \$1,800 in lost property tax revenue. The City does have the authority to terminate the agreement and/or take legal actions. However, by extending the deadline may be in the best interest of the City.

Police Policies & Procedures – updating of the police policies and procedures was discussed during budget worksessions but at the time it was decided to investigate other options due to the high annual fee with Lexipol. Since then, the violence and riots surrounding police policies and procedures has pushed this subject to be a much higher priority. After some research by the Police Chief he is recommending entering into a contract with Lexipol for updating the P&P and utilizing the training options. This is not budgeted and we need a new proposal if we decide to proceed and will need to do a budget amendment.

RAGBRAI CD – after the last RAGBRAI we had money left over. This was mainly from donations received from businesses and the City. It was decided to keep this money for start-up money if RAGBRAI comes through Cresco again in the future and we need to fund another event. It has been in a 3-year CD that is maturing on 9/14/2020 for almost \$8,900. Council needs to decide if they want to do another 2 or 3-year CD and commit the funds for future RAGBRAI expenditures.

Energy Review – Since the installation of solar (and before), Council Member Bouska has diligently been tracking energy costs for the City. She has summarized it and will present her findings.

Council Vacancy – Unfortunately we have a vacant Council seat, so Council needs to decide if you want to fill it by appointment or have a special election. A Notice of Intent must be published prior to making an appointment. The appointment must be made within 60 days so by October 26, 2020. There is a black-out period for 32 days prior to the Presidential election so it will be tough meeting all the deadlines for a special election. An election will cost approximately \$2,000.

Scene Shop Demolition - At budget time we had no idea what the cost and whether we would proceed with the demolition and rebuilding of the scene shop. It has become apparent that we NEED to demolish the building as soon as possible. Whether we proceed with replacing it with a building or just permanently capping off the end of the Theatre remains to be determined based on projected costs. There is still uncertainty as to the total cost of the project but we currently need to set up a capital project fund for this project and will need to transfer \$40,000 of LOST money into this fund for the asbestos removal, demolition, and architectural phase one fees. We have received an estimate of almost \$24,000 for the demolition of the scene shop and capping the south end of the Theatre building.

Michelle

Mayor Bohle called the Cresco City Council meeting to order on August 17, 2020, at 7:00 pm. Council Members Brenno, McCarville, Fortune, Bouska, and Carman were present. No council members were absent.

Bouska made the motion to approve the consent agenda which included approval of the: agenda; claims; minutes of the August 3rd meeting and worksession and August 5th special meeting with Planning & Zoning. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Public Works Director Freidhof reported: (a) Street Department is repairing intakes, spray patching, and chip sealing; (b) Water Department is repairing valves and repaired a watermain leak on 3rd St SW; (c) Sewer Department is repairing manholes and repaired a water leak at the WWTP. We will need to discuss replacement of this at budget time due to several leaks in last few years; (d) Bergo Environmental will be here in about 3 weeks for asbestos abatement at the Scene Shop. They applied for the DNR permit. We will apply for reimbursement of this expense from the Zonolite Trust; (e) Vernon Springs Brewery will need to pretreat their waste to address potential pH issues.

Police Chief Ruroden reported they are still accepting applications to fill the open position after Officer Cox resigned. They have been busy with investigations. Part-time Officer Doepke is putting in long hours in Cedar Rapids doing cleanup for the DOT. The new truck has been ordered and delivery should be in December.

City Clerk Girolamo reported: (a) the next council meeting will be Wednesday September 9, 2020 due to the Labor Day holiday; (b) working online preparing the AFR and SFR so they can be tied to the Audit Report so that can be finished up; (c) compiling and preparing to apply for a FEMA grant for COVID reimbursement; (d) Park & Rec will not have 5th & 6th tackle football this year but are hoping to offer flag football and volleyball this fall and basketball in the winter. Fees will not be collected until the start of the program in case they need to be cancelled; (e) we received a \$2,000 Howard County Community Foundation Grant today which was funded by Alvin & Karen Voyna Family Fund for Prairie Springs Recreational Trail repair.

McCarville reported the Airport Commission is working on increasing the hangar rent. It appears that there is only one person seriously interested in a hangar so they have decided not to proceed with building new hangars at this time.

Bouska reported the Regional Housing Committee meeting was postponed until next month. The Personnel Committee is meeting with all supervisors in following up on employee surveys. They will report to Council when they are completed.

Brenno reported that he was going to discuss the Park & Rec activities and that they are just not sure how everything will work out, so they are being flexible. Fitness Center memberships are down 28 to about 660. They are looking at purchasing a new treadmill. East Park bleacher project did not receive any bids but they are working with a contractor to get a quote.

Mayor Bohle reported the Cresco Tractor Pullers have withdrawn their request for a street closure.

Mayor Bohle performed the third reading of Ordinance 485 to amend Section 5.12 in the City of Cresco Code of Ordinances pertaining to the residency requirement. Bouska made the motion to approve the third reading. Brenno seconded and it passed all ayes. Carman made the motion to approve Ordinance 485. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Carman made the motion to approve the resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign a Temporary Construction Easement for the 5th Avenue Southwest Storm Sewer. Bouska seconded and it passed all ayes.

Carman made the motion to approve a resolution directing the City Clerk to file the COVID-19 Streamlined Project Application with FEMA. Brenno seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to approve a resolution requesting reimbursement from the Iowa COVID-19 Government Relief Fund. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to set the public Hearing for Proposed Ordinance No. 486 to Amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, by Amending Provisions Pertaining to Fireworks. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to approve the first reading of the summary of proposed Ordinance No. 486. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

Bouska made the motion to approve a resolution authorizing the approval of and participation in a Joint Powers Agreement and declaration of trust for the Iowa Public Agency Investment Trust, authorizing investments through the Fixed Term Automated Investment Program of IPAIT and authorizing IPAIT to designate and name depositories. Brenno seconded and it passed all ayes.

A summary of the long-term debt interest rates were reviewed. Most are not callable until June 2021 and 2022. It is expensive and takes a long time to go through the process. Council requested that Piper Jaffray be contacted to review our options and get us estimates of the cost and potential savings.

Bouska made the motion to waive the building permit and connection fees for BDM Developers, LLC for the condos being built in accordance with the Development Agreement. Fortune seconded and it passed all ayes.

The Board of Adjustments is having a public hearing on August 25, 2020. This is the second step in the approval process for the Cresco Food Technologies' request for a special use permit.

The City received a letter of noncompliance from the Iowa DNR. The city actively addresses I&I issues and annually performs inspections and slip lining of sewer mains. The main issue is the south lift station. Council will discuss another sump pump inspection program on the south side where we have the most issues during heavy rainfalls.

Iowa League of Cities is recommending that cities should consider using envelopes instead of postcards for utility bills due to privacy issues. The additional cost is estimated to be about \$260 per month for the 1500 bills mailed. The postcards are often lost or damaged in the mail service. Council agreed that we should switch to mailing bills in an envelope and consider a promotion to encourage emailing of bills.

A street light needs to be replaced by the Library. We will contact Alliant to see if they will take over ownership. The issue is getting permanent wiring to the light. The Library wants to make sure the light remains on that corner.

Library Director Kay reported the Library is still closed but are allowing patrons in to use computers on a reservation basis. The Fitness Center, Theatre, and City Hall are working well with the COVID precautions that have been implemented. Mayor Bohle has received calls from residents concerned about the public taking the COVID seriously and not wearing masks. He reminded the public to be aware of COVID issues and to respect other people. Howard County has one of the highest per capita rates of COVID even though our total number of cases are lower than surrounding counties.

Mayor Bohle asked for comments from the audience and there were none.

Carman moved to adjourn at 7:35 pm. Brenno seconded and it passed all ayes. The next regular Cresco City Council meeting will be Wednesday, September 9, 2020, at 7:00 pm at Cresco City Hall.

Chairperson Kevin Weinacht called the Cresco Board of Adjustments meeting to order on August 25, 2020, at 7:00 pm in City Hall. The public hearing was opened regarding a special use permit application. Cresco Food Technologies applied for the permit to construct a 100-foot exhaust stack for a spray dryer on the southeast corner of their building. A fire in the spray dryer in Spring 2020 destroyed the stack.

The City of Cresco owns property within 500 hundred feet of CFT property and therefore was invited to the public hearing. Mayor Bohle and Council Members Brenno, Fortune, and Bouska attended. Council Members Carman and McCarville were absent.

The minutes from the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting held on August 4, 2020, were read aloud that included a recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Commission to approve the special use permit application filed by Cresco Food Technologies LLC.

CFT Site Manager, Tom Watson, stated that that the request to build a taller stack in place of the old stack is an effort to eliminate the odor. The taller stack provides no benefit to the plant. Comments were received from the public and council members regarding odor issues.

After a short discussion by the Board of Adjustment members, a motion was made and seconded to approve the special use permit and was passed unanimously by the Board of Adjustments.

The City Council did not take any formal action during the meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 pm. The next regular Cresco City Council meeting will be September 9, 2020, at 7:00 pm at Cresco City Hall.

60.08 PARADES REGULATED. No person shall conduct or cause any parade on any street except as provided herein:

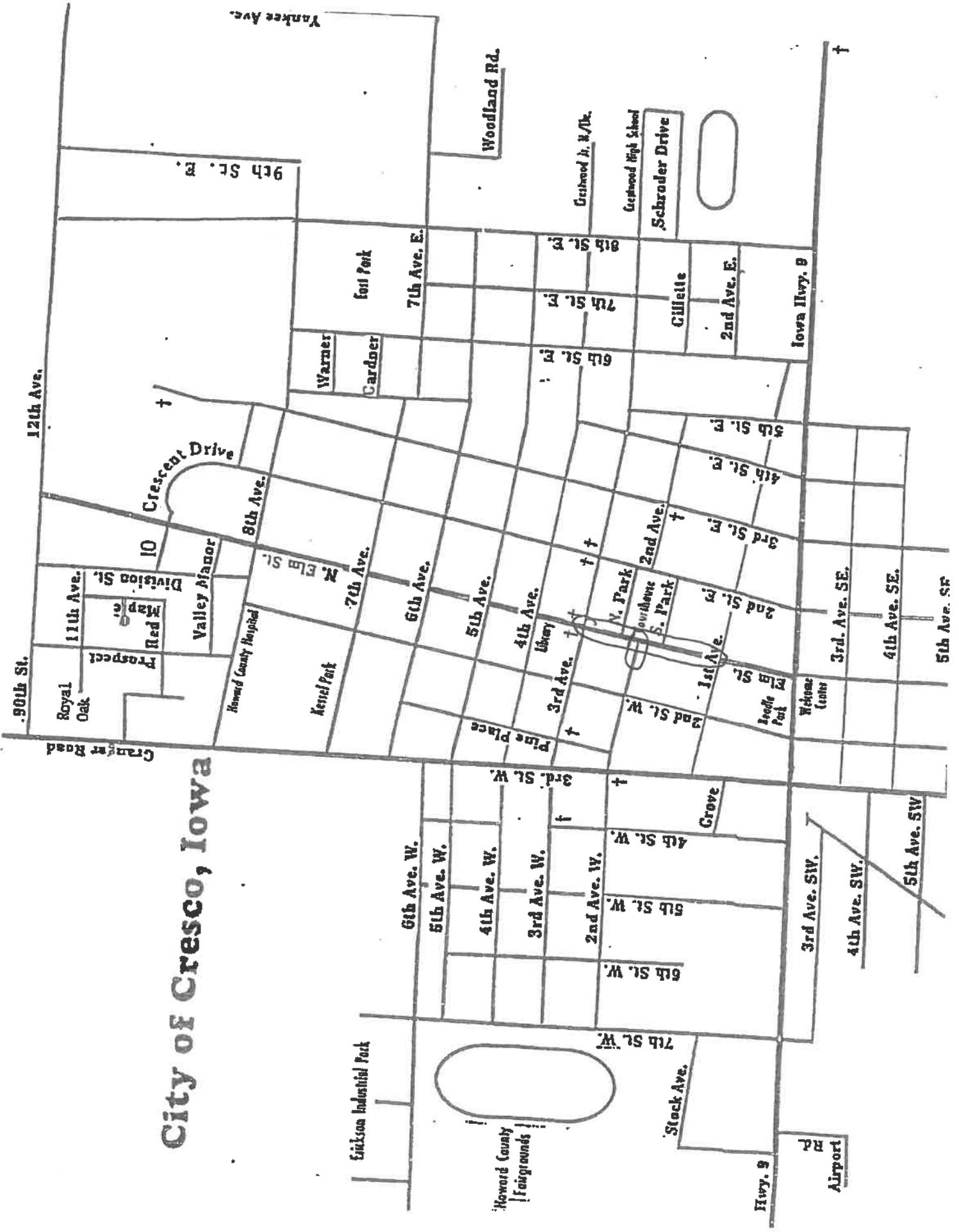
1. "Parade" Defined. "Parade" means any march or procession of persons or vehicles organized for marching or moving on the streets in an organized fashion or manner or any march or procession of persons or vehicles represented or advertised to the public as a parade.
2. Permit Required. No parade shall be conducted without first obtaining a written permit from the City Council. Such permit shall state the time and date for the parade to be held and the streets or general route therefor. Such written permit granted to the person organizing or sponsoring the parade shall be permission for all participants therein to parade when such participants have been invited by the permittee to participate therein. No fee shall be required for such permit. Permit forms are available at City Hall.
3. Parade Not a Street Obstruction. Any parade for which a permit has been issued as herein required, and the persons lawfully participating therein, shall not be deemed an obstruction of the streets notwithstanding the provisions of any other ordinance to the contrary.
4. Control by Police and Firefighters. Persons participating in any parade shall at all times be subject to the lawful orders and directions in the performance of their duties of law enforcement personnel and members of the Fire Department.

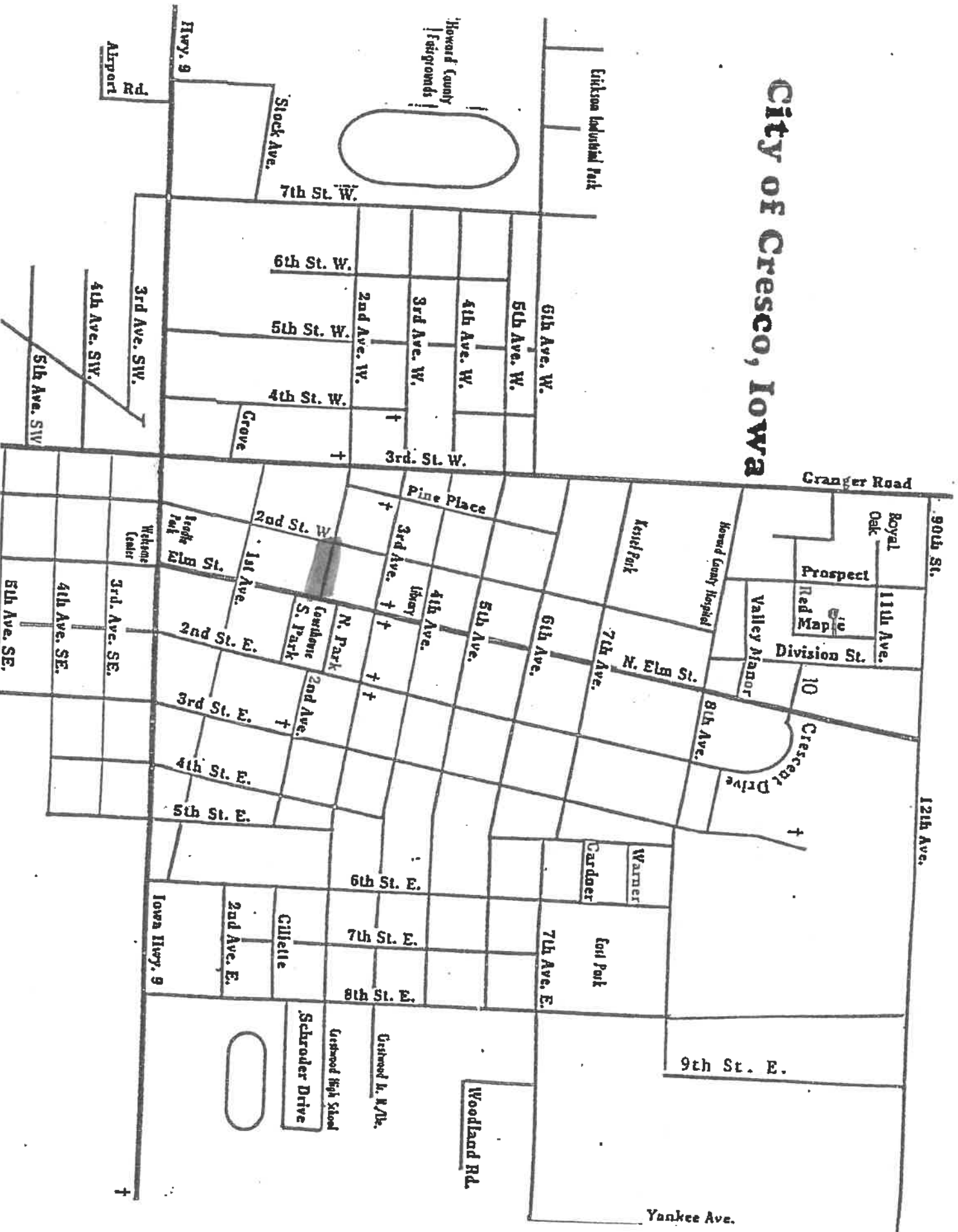

Such written permit granted to the person organizing or sponsoring the parade shall be permission for all participants therein to parade when such participants have been invited by the permittee to participate therein. No fee shall be required for such permit. Permit forms are available at City Hall.
- 3. Parade Not a Street Obstruction. Any parade for which a permit has been issued as herein required, and the persons lawfully participating therein, shall not be deemed an obstruction of the streets notwithstanding the provisions of any other ordinance to the contrary.
- 4. Control by Police and Firefighters. Persons participating in any parade shall at all times be subject to the lawful orders and directions in the performance of their duties of law enforcement personnel and members of the Fire Department.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA, BY AMENDING
PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS

Below is a summary of ORDINANCE 486. A full copy of said Ordinance may be obtained between 8 am and 4:30 pm weekdays at City Hall, 130 North Park Place, Cresco, IA 52136 or on the City's website at www.cityofcresco.com.

SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Section 13, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, is repealed and this Section is adopted in lieu thereof:

41.13 FIREWORKS. The sale, use and exploding of fireworks within the City are subject to the following:

1. **Definition.** Consumer Fireworks shall have the same meanings as defined in Iowa Code section 727.2. Consumer Fireworks do not include novelties enumerated in chapter 3 of the American Pyrotechnic Association's standard 87-1.

2. **Discharge of Consumer Fireworks.**

A. Only allowed July 3rd between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. and July 4th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.

B. Must be on their own real property or on property where consent has been given.

C. Shall not be discharged by persons showing visible signs of, or determined to be, intoxicated or under the influence of a drug or narcotic.

D. Person discharging assumes all responsibility and shall not discharge a consumer fireworks device in a reckless manner or manner likely to cause death, injury, fire, or property damage.

E. Violation of this subsection commits a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 up to \$625.00.

3. **Exception for Display Fireworks.** Applications may be approved by City authorities when Display Fireworks will be handled by a competent operator. Certificate of Insurance must accompany the application with minimum coverages of:

1. Personal Injury.....\$250,000 per person
2. Property Damage.....\$50,000
3. Total Exposure.....\$1,000,000

4. **Sales.** An application may be filed with City Hall to sell consumer grade fireworks after first securing a Retail Fireworks License through the State of Iowa Fire Marshal's Office. Dates of sales are limited by Iowa Code.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF CRESCO, IOWA, BY AMENDING
PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO FIREWORKS

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Cresco, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Section 13, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cresco, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

41.13 FIREWORKS. The sale, use and exploding of fireworks within the City are subject to the following:

1. **Definition.** Consumer Fireworks shall have the same meanings as defined in Iowa Code section 727.2. Consumer Fireworks do not include novelties enumerated in chapter 3 of the American Pyrotechnic Association's standard 87-1.

A. First-Class Consumer Fireworks include aerial shell kits and reloadable tubes; chasers; helicopter and aerial spinners; firecrackers; mine and shell devices; missile-type rockets; roman candles; sky rockets and bottle rockets; multiple tube devices manufactured in accordance with APA 87-1, section 3.5.

B. Second-Class Consumer Fireworks include cone fountains; cylindrical fountains; flitter sparklers; grand and hand-held sparkling devices; ground spinners; illuminating torches; toy smoke devices and wheels and wire or dipped sparklers that are not classified as novelties pursuant to APA 87-1, section 3.2.

C. Display Fireworks include any explosive composition, or combination of explosive substances, or article prepared of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation, and includes fireworks containing any explosive or flammable compound, or other device containing any explosive substance. Display fireworks do not include consumer fireworks.

2. **Discharge of Consumer Fireworks.**

A. A person shall not use or explode consumer fireworks on days other than July 3rd between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. and July 4th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.

B. A person shall not use consumer fireworks on real property other than that person's real property or on property where consent has been given.

C. Consumer fireworks shall not be discharged by persons showing visible signs of, or determined to be, intoxicated or under the influence of a drug or narcotic.

D. Any person discharging a consumer fireworks device assumes all responsibility for its operation and the consequences thereof. No person shall discharge a consumer fireworks device in a reckless manner or manner likely to cause death, injury, fire, or property damage.

E. Violation of this subsection commits a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 up to \$625.00.

3. **Exception for Display Fireworks.** The City may, upon application in writing, grant a permit for Display Fireworks by a City agency, fair associations, amusement parks and other organizations or groups of individuals approved by City authorities when such fireworks display will be handled by a competent operator.

A. Competent Operator must either be a PGI Certified Shooter or must attest to following safety precautions and studied the Iowa Pyrotechnic Association Display Operator Course online.

B. No permit shall be granted hereunder unless the operator or sponsoring organization has filed with the City evidence of insurance in the following amounts:

1. Personal Injury.....\$250,000 per person
2. Property Damage.....\$50,000
3. Total Exposure.....\$1,000,000

4. **Other Exceptions.** This section does not prohibit the sale or use of blank cartridges for a show or theatre, or for signal purposes in athletic sports or by railroads or trucks for signal purposes, or by a recognized military organization. This section does not apply to any substance or composition prepared and sold for medicinal or fumigation purposes.

5. **Sales.** No person shall sell or offer for sale consumer grade fireworks without first securing a Retail Fireworks License through the State Fire Marshal's Office for the State of Iowa.

A. City Permit. An application must be filed with City Hall that includes:

1. The location and dates for the sale of fireworks. Sales of consumer fireworks are allowed only within districts zoned as Commercial C-1 or C-2 and Industrial M-1.
2. Proof of Licensing from the Office of the State Fire Marshal.
3. Proof of Liability Insurance covering all aspects of consumer fireworks sales for a minimum amount per occurrence of \$1,000,000 and a minimum aggregate amount of \$2,000,000.
4. Sales within a permanent structure or building shall be allowed between June 1 and July 8 and December 10 until January 3.

5. Approved temporary structure or stand sales shall be allowed between June 13 and July 8.
6. The following information must be stated in an easily readable type size and prominently posted at the place of payment at each location selling Consumer Fireworks:
 - (a) The use or explosion of Consumer Fireworks within the city limits is prohibited on days other than July 3rd between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. and July 4th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.; and
 - (b) A violation of City of Cresco Code Section 41.13 (2) constitutes a simple misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$250.00 up to \$625.00.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

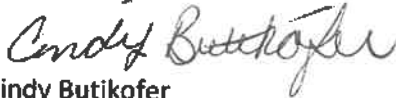
